### Region 8

#### 3.3. U14

- 3.3.1. Each team plays at least 4 matches on each of the scheduled weekends they elect to participate in 3.3.1.1. Teams electing to participate in more weekends have more opportunities to earn points
- 3.3.2. The results of all matches played each weekend are compiled together with final rankings determined according to Regulation 1.7

#### 3.4. U16

- 3.4.1. Each team plays at least 4 matches on each of the scheduled weekends they elect to participate in 3.4.1.1. Teams electing to participate in more weekends have more opportunities to earn points
- 3.4.2. The results of all matches played each weekend are compiled together and initial pool rankings are determined according to Regulation 1.7
- 3.4.3. The two teams electing only to play in the opening weekend at Richmond will be ranked  $8^{th} 9^{th}$  as according to Regulation 1.7.
- 3.4.4. The seven teams registered for the Virgina Beach weekend will play final classification matches on the Championship date as follows below
